

**SOCIAL VISIT PASS (LONG TERM)**

<b>Eligibility criteria</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Children above 18 years old and unmarried of Employment Pass holder; OR</li><li>2. Parents &amp; Parents-in-law of Employment Pass holder.; OR</li><li>3. Common law spouse of Employment Pass holder can be considered</li></ol>
<b>Features</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Allows the holder to stay in West Malaysia</li><li>2. Employment is not allowed and requires conversion to Employment Pass</li><li>3. One (1) time application and change of partner is not allowed for common law spouse</li></ol>
<b>Documents required</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Recent passport photo with light blue colour background</li><li>2. Copy of passport (full booklet with cover)</li><li>3. Copy of Birth Certificate (for children above 18 years old) translated* into English (if applicable) and Certified True Copy (CTC) by the Embassy/High Commission/Consulate General of respective country OR respective Embassy/High Commission/Consulate General in Malaysia</li><li>4. Copy of Birth Certificate of Employment Pass holder / Employment Pass holder's spouse (for Parents and Parents-in-law) translated* into English (if applicable) and Certified True Copy (CTC) by the Embassy/High Commission/Consulate General of respective country OR respective Embassy/High Commission/Consulate General in Malaysia</li><li>5. Affidavit / Acknowledgement letter from the Employment Pass holder's Embassy / Consulate General on the relationship status (for common law spouse)</li><li>6. Personal Bond form (duly stamped by Inland Revenue Board);</li><li>7. Other documents specified upon request * Translation must be done either by the Respective Embassy/ High Commission/ Consulate General or Institut Terjemahan Buku Malaysia</li></ol>
