

INVITATION FOR NEW DEPENDENT PASS

WHO CAN BRING THEIR FAMILY

Postgraduate students can bring their family/dependent into Malaysia. According to the Immigration Circular (1995), undergraduate students are not allowed to bring any dependent during his/her stay here.

HOW AND WHEN

Students were advised to enter this country alone at first prior to issuance of Student Pass. Dependent Pass can only be applied after the Student Pass is approved and issued.

For the family who is still in their home country, please fill the 'Application form to Obtain Invitation Letter For Dependents' and submit to Visa Unit. Visa Unit will take at least 3 days to deliver the letter to the student to take home.

WHAT TO FILL-IN THE FORM

- ❖ Particular of Applicant
- ❖ Address of the Malaysian Embassy in your country
- ❖ Particulars of the family members to be invited

DOCUMENTS TO ATTACH WITH THE FORM

- ❖ A set of student passport copies
- ❖ A copy of the passport for each member (Detail of the passport holder)
- ❖ A copy of the Relationship letter from Embassy

CATEGORY OF FAMILY

- Biological parents of the student
- Husband or wife of the student
- Children of the student (Children above the age of 17 years old is not entitled for Dependent Pass)

ADDITIONAL TO THE DEPENDENT FEES

- New dependent will be charged an additional **Journey Performed (JP)** fees of RM520.00 each person
- This requirement will also apply for those who are on a Single Entry Visa (Social/Tourist) obtained from the Malaysian Embassy/ Consulate in their home country.
