1	IIF2002	Teori dan Amalan Takaful di Malaysia <i>Theory and Application of Takaful in Malaysia</i>	No	3		√	This course will expose student on the function of takaful as an instruments for protection and saving, the takaful contracts and analyze the role of takaful in the economics.
2	IIF2004	Transaksi dalam Ekonomi Islam <i>Transactions in Islamic Economics</i>	No	3		√	This course discuss about the theory of transactions in Islamic economics, theory of wealth and ownership, formation of aqd, prohibition in the aqd such as riba, gharar and maysir; transactions in debt financing, transactions in equity financing, transactions in deposits mobilizations, transactions in the investment of property ownership, working capital and services, transactions in trade financing, transactions in inter-bank money market, money exchange, transactions in Islamic capital market, etc.
3	GII1002	Institusi Ekonomi Islam <i>Islamic Economic Institutions</i>	No	2	√	√	This course aims to expose the student about the concepts, the role and operation of the Islamic economic institutions such as charitable institutions, financial institutions and regulatory institutions.

1	IIM2001	Kontrak Muamalat <i>Muamalah Contract</i>	No	3		√	This course is an advanced course in fiqh al-muamalat knowledge that further extend the discussion on detail aspects of main contracts in Islamic muamalah particularly on its application in Islamic banking system and finance. Focus would be given on conditions of formation, responsibility and express or implicit terms, completion, solution and effects of breach of contract. Students will also be exposed to how current development affects the conditions precedents to the contract and the modifications done to fulfill the requirements of legal and business infrastructure of Malaysian law. Brief comparison with the Law of Contract in Malaysia will also be conducted.
2	IIM2003	Undang-Undang Pusaka, Wasiat dan Hibah <i>Islamic Law of Inheritance, Will and Gift</i>	No	3	√		This course discusses fundamental aspects of Islamic law of inheritance, will and gift. Its purpose is to introduce the legal as well as practical aspects of Islamic inheritance, will and gift in general. References will be done to HukumSyarak, applicable Islamic law and take into account other written laws which are also applied in Malaysia.
3	IIM3012	Undang-Undang Pengguna <i>Consumer Law</i>	No	3		√	Generally this subject focuses on main legal principles relating to consumer issues. Its covers consumer issues, product liability, consumer credit and product safety. In addition, exposes students to cheating and dishonour business practice such as misuse of advertisement, abusing halal signage, Muslim food and product, pyramid system and others. Other scope includes practical aspect such as legal access. Other than court as litigation, Consumer Claim Tribunal is other avenue for hearing consumer claim.

4	IIM4004	Undang-Undang Perbankan dan Kewangan Islam <i>Islamic Banking and Financial Law</i>	No	3	√		This course is the extension of the fiqh al-Muamalat and contract of muamalat. It describes details application of the main contracts of Islamic Muamalat in the Islamic Banking and Islamic Finance system. The discussion includes topics such as the background of Contract and Commercial Law in Malaysia and its relation with Islamic Muamalat, Approval process and the control of Islamic Finance in Malaysia, and the jurisdiction of court and Islamic muamalat and the issues arising in court cases. The principle and application of banking product and islamic financial including Takaful
5	IIM4008	Undang-Undang dan Pentadbiran Wakaf <i>Law and Administration of Wakaf</i>	No	3	√		This course discusses the fundamental law of wakaf concepts according to the Islamic law perspective. The discussion will involve the applicable laws for the administration and management of wakaf property in Malaysia especially regarding the powers given to the States Islamic Religious Council as its sole trustee in the country. The discussion will then concerns the legal and management of wakaf property in Malaysia such as analysis on the statutory provisions relating to the property, its legal principles, provisions relating to family wakaf, issues on land development and wakaf propert, application of istibdal concept and jurisdictional conflicts between syariah and civil courts in the said matter. Basic drafting of wakaf documents and contract is also taught to the students.
6	IIM4010	Undang-Undang Zakat dan Baitulmal <i>Laws of Zakat and Baitulmal</i>	No	3		√	This course contains information relating to the jurisdiction of the relevant institutions governing the administration and management of zakat and baitulmal in Malaysia. The applicable laws and power of collection and distribution of the properties besides matters relating to the contemporary practice of the zakat collection and its payment system are also discussed. In addition, issues on the enforcement of the law, imposition of zakat to incapacitated people, tax incentives involving rebate and deduction on individuals and companies including those of the Labuan Offshore under Labuan Offshore Business Activity Tax Act 1990 (LOBATA) are also included. The imposition of zakat to some contemporary assets, for example the savings of the Employee Provident Fund (EPF), zakat on income, shares and others will also be discussed. The Islamic law of zakat and baitulmal is also included.
