It will discuss the conceptual framework of Muslims and their methodology in approaching Islamic Jerusalem. Some questions such as why Muslims have close link with Islamic Jerusalem will be explored. The relation between Muslims and non-Muslims would also be discussed. Another aspect which will be highlighted is the current situation; an analysis from global political perspective and peace process towards peace and stability in Middle East.	NIL
